- Psychological education and mental health of users during the war;
- Peculiarities of personnel management during the war;
- Professional standard “Librarian”.

- Ways to ensure specialized storage regimes for book and archival collections, preventive measures under martial law;
- Supporting user requests from memorial collections;
- Exposition and excursion work to reveal the national and world significance of book and archival monuments;
- Organization of access to information resources of library, archival and museum collections via the Internet;
- Examination and selection of unique and particularly valuable documents for digitization, ensuring the completeness of electronic copies of monuments;
- Results of scientific research and bibliographic disclosure of library archival and museum collections of national and world importance;
- Preparation of scientific information on monuments of writing and printing that are to be included in the State Register of National Cultural Heritage.

2. The sequence of the text on the page (index UDC, name of the report (in uppercase letters, size 14), surname, name, patronymic name of the author, post, full name of the institution, country, city, annotation and keywords (Ukrainian, English), text, list of bibliographic references.
